1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNS on behalf of accused-applicant. The accused-applicant was arrested in connection with FIR No. 07/2024 registered at Police Station Cyber Crime Police Station Baran, District Baran for the offence(s) under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 319(2), 61(2) of BNS, 2023 and Section 66-C, 66D of IT Act, 2008.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant has submitted that the applicant is sole bread earner of the family, aged about 22 years. It is further submitted that the charge-sheet has been filed in the matter and that the applicant is behind custody for a period of approximately two and a half months. It is also submitted that the matter is triable by the Magistrate.



3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the instant bail application and has submitted that the several complaints are registered against the applicant on the National Cyber Crime Portal (through Registered Number: 1930), and financial transaction of enormous amount is involved in the instant matter.

4. Having heard the submissions made by learned counsel for the respective parties and taking note of the fact that the applicant is sole bread earner of the family, aged about 22 years; that the applicant is behind custody for a period of approximately two and a half months; that the charge-sheet has already been filed; that the matter at hand is triable by the Magistrate, and considering the overall facts and circumstances but without commenting upon the merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the accused-applicant on bail.

5. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is **allowed** and it is ordered that accused-applicant **Kamlesh Kumar S/o Balmukund Sharma** shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
