1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-applicant. The accused-applicant was arrested in connection with FIR No. 248/2025 registered at Police Station Baroda Meo District Alwar for the offence(s) under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 112(2), 61(2) of BNS, 2023 and Section 66(D) of IT Act, 2008.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that applicant is a sole bread earner of the family, is in custody since 30.09.2025, and that charge-sheet has been filed in the instant matter. It is submitted that the alleged offence is siphoning of Rs.57,000/- by using bank account, on basis of commission.
3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the instant bail application.





4. Having heard the submissions made by learned counsel for the respective parties, considering the overall facts and taking note of the fact that applicant is a sole bread earner of the family; that the applicant has been in custody since 30.09.2025; that charge-sheet has been filed in the instant matter, and taking note of the overall facts and circumstances of the instant matter, but without commenting upon the merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the accused-applicant on bail.

5. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is **allowed** and it is ordered that accused-applicant **Tahir S/o Late Shri Illiyas** shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
