Judgment / Order

1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayer:-

"A. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction directing the respondent-RPSC to correct the subject in the petitioner's Application No. 202549023583 from "Hindi" to "Geography", in accordance with her academic qualification and earlier application record;





B. Direct the respondent to consider the petitioner's candidature for the post of Assistant Professor (College Education) - 2025 in the subject Geography and permit her to participate in all subsequent stages of the recruitment process accordingly;

C. Quash and set aside the verbal/ oral refusal of the respondent-Commission to consider the petitioner's representation;

D. Direct the respondent to pass a reasoned and speaking order on the petitioner's representation dated 01-12-2025;

2. During course of arguments, learned counsel for petitioner referred judgment passed by a Division Bench of this Court in case of **Union of India and Ors. Vs. Harendra Gawaria and Ors. 2022 Supreme (Raj,) 643** and submits that the controversy raised herein is already resolved and the petitioner may be granted permission to file an appropriate representation to respondents-Authority to consider and resolve her grievances.
3. Considered the grievance raised herein, the petitioner is given a liberty to submit a representation to the respondents-Authority within a period of 3 days raising all grounds and the respondents-Authority are directed to consider and decide the representation after enquiry about grievances, raised by the petitioner in light of **Union of India and Ors. Vs. Harendra Gawaria and Ors. (supra)**, but in case of deviation with a reasoned and speaking order within a period of 7 days (before 15th December 2025) from date of receipt of representation. After the decision, the





respondents are under an obligation to communicate the decision to the petitioner either by way of speed post or through E-mail, if petitioner has provided E-mail in her representation. If the petitioner is still aggrieved, she is at liberty to approach this Court with fresh petition.

4. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition with pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
